MAURICE ELLIS AWARD

"Father Ellis" was a pioneer and is recognised for his vigorous campaigning for the improvement of emergency medical services throughout the United Kingdom.

The Maurice Ellis Award recognises his pioneering work in the field of Emergency Medicine. It may be awarded every two years and presented at an appropriate event in the College of Emergency Medicine calendar. The following regulations shall apply:-

1. Eligibility is restricted to fully paid-up members of the College of Emergency Medicine.
2. The prize is awarded as a travelling scholarship to facilitate education or research in the field of Emergency Medicine.
3. Applicants must give details of completed preparatory work and a planned itinerary. Unsupported proposals of a general nature will not be accepted.
4. The value of the Award will be up to £3,000 (three thousand pounds) only varied after discussion at the Executive Committee on the recommendation of the Honorary Treasurer and with the approval of the Annual General Meeting.
5. The winner is to be named the Maurice Ellis Scholar.
6. The winner will be required to present a report at the Annual General Meeting which follows the completion of his/her studies.
7. The Award should be determined by the Research & Publications Committee of the College of Emergency Medicine, with or without the advice of external assessors.
8. No limit is set as to the number of consecutive applications by any one CEM member.
9. No one CEM member may be awarded The Maurice Ellis Prize on more than one occasion.
10. The Award should not be used 'as a top-up' for an applicant who has received another award or funding for the same project.
